Data is huge

• Banks, city councils, governments, shops, etc.

- Facebook processes 750TB/day of data
 - 48k iPhones every day
 - 7PB of photo storage / month

This requires computers (a lot of them)

Machines

- Google has around 900,000 servers (260 million watts) 0.01% global energy
- CERN Large Hadron Collider 180MW
- The flux-capacitor needs 1.21 GW (just 5xGoogle)

Well, machines are not enough

Human Computation

- Combine both the scalability of machines as well as the ability of human intelligence
- Outsource tasks from computers to a crowd of people

Crowdsourcing

 Portmanteau of "crowd" and "outsourcing," first coined by Jeff Howe in a June 2006 Wired magazine article

 [Merriam-Webster] the practice of obtaining needed services, ideas, or content by soliciting contributions from a large group of people and especially from the online community rather than from traditional employees or suppliers










Demographics of MTurk workers


Household Income for US workers




Household Income for Indian workers




Year of Birth for US workers




Year of Birth for Indian workers






